

Ross behaves horribly to those he loves most, but in the end he does right by the one who has loved him most of all. All the characters from the previous novels are still there, even one you never expected to see again. Totally addicted to this series back in the 70's watching it on

Masterpiece Theatre Sunday nights with my mom and sisters. I eagerly gobbled up the first 4 books 1945 - Ross Poldark 1946 - Demelza 1950 - Jeremy Poldark 1953 - Warleggan. Were I to have named them it would have been Poldark; Demelza; Warleggan; Elizabeth. I stopped reading the series in 1977 as the novels had gotten so dark that I wasn't enjoying where the author was taking the characters. 1973 - The Black Moon 1976 - The Four Swans 1977 - The Angry Tidel was poking in a book store on vacation and picked up 'The Twisted Sword' and enjoyed it tremendously (with one exception - I didn't care for the outcome for Jeremy at all).
