


The book was found

I liked this trilogy. It keeps the characters from each book ahead of it included in the story. Each female and male main character in each book struggles with a self imposed belief or they remain true to their relationship and beliefs in God. This book is about Phoebe and Adrian. Adrian is the one with the biggest problem. He has killed a man protecting a woman from train robbers and he leaves his home and family to protect them but he also believes he isn't good enough to have his dreams of a family of his own because he has killed a man whether it was to protect someone else or not. Phoebe runs the store for the mining company he purchased and relocated to in Silver Hills. She has relocated to here after she got married after leaving a 'religious group' because she didn't agree with all their beliefs, such as men and women should each live celibate lives in service to God. Her husband is killed while investigating some crooked ongoings in the mines. He is also a 'youth pastor' for the local church. They are attracted to each other immediately but Phoebe believes she is still in mourning and her attraction is a disloyalty to her past husband and Adrian believes he is unfit and doesn't deserve a wife so they fight the attraction. Its a good story and you want to keep reading to see what happens with Adrian and Phoebe. Adrian starts believing that there is something crooked going on in the mine and a young woman shows up with a baby looking for her husband who works in the mine. He's been killed but they don't know that yet. This young woman and her husband are Chinese, two of many who have come to make a living in the mines. Phoebe ends up raising this couple's baby. Adrian's past catches up with him. There is something crooked going on at the mine's. I won't tell you any more. Get the book and enjoy it.

This is book 2 in the Silver Hills Trilogy. This book tells the story of Phoebe, a recent widow from a cave-in at the mine. Her Shaker background is something that certain people in the town are more

than happy to hold against her. She feels that the people weren't bad, they just were misguided in their beliefs. Now that her husband is gone, she runs the mercantile that is run by the mining company. Her future rests in the hands of the new owner. Adrian is on the run. He's hoping that he'll be able to fade into the background as the new owner of the mine, but he discovers that the more privacy he desires, the more attention he draws to himself. He tries to stay away from Phoebe, for her own sake as much as his, but circumstances don't make that possible. They end up working together to solve problems with the treatment of the Chinamen, find out about an opium problem and try to solve murders. I enjoyed this book. I found that Phoebe and her friends struck me as a little "holier than thou" at times, and I thought that Adrian was almost a little too cowardly at times. The end also seemed a little rushed. Even with these minor issues, I found myself wanting to find out if Adrian makes peace with his past and if he and Phoebe can get together. I purposely looked at the names involved in the first book to see if I would feel like I was missing anything by reading them out of order. While I saw the names and read a little of their background, I didn't feel like it would be an absolute necessity to read them in order. Book 1 is called Light of My Heart and book 3 is Spring of My Love. Overall, I liked it and look forward to reading more from this author.

I was anxious to begin reading this second book of the Silver Hills Trilogy since the first book was so good. I was not disappointed. Phoebe was such a sweet and helpful girl, Adrian could not help but fall in love with her. There are mysteries a plenty and suspense. A great read.
